I recognize that I have the power to make a positive difference in the care and healing of the Creation of which I am a part.


I choose, therefore, to undertake a personal conversion of heart--embracing, respecting, and reverencing every thing that God has made.


I choose to pray in thanksgiving for the earth and all its creatures, and ask God for guidance and wisdom in how I can be a better steward, and a better creature.
