

Individual Response


- Walk instead of driving.

Parish Response


- Install solar panels on the church roof

- Reach out to community representative for neighborhood action.
- More frequent brown bag making session.
- More donation of clothing for specific needs and for a particular place.

- Incentives offered for participation and success.
- Ask local school Principal to be invited to a PTA meeting and be a guest speaker to inform parents.

We pray to you, O God, help us renew our commitment to care for the earth. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen."








